






Ongoing challenges

- Lack of financial resources
- Lack of trained personnel
- Little continuity Government; UNGEGN
- Little realization of advantages of a good toponymy for the country
- Competition between Government departments
- Work with UNECA, with other countries, with UNGEGN continuous process of awareness and development



UNGEGN's Task Team for Africa



Since 2004, revitalization process in Africa to assist with geographical names standardization

(Brahim Atoui, Algeria)

- Liaison with African organizations promote benefits and seek finances ... African Union, UNECA ... Geographical names on conference agendas ... e.g. CODIST, GIS Africa
- Cooperation with African agencies to support organization of training
 - Tunis, Ouagadougou, Nairobi, Yaoundé
- Efforts to re-invigorate UNGEGN's African regional divisions and encourage collaboration
 - West, East, Central, South
 - Arabic, Dutch- and German-speaking, Frenchspeaking + Portuguese-speaking
- 25th UNGEGN held in Africa (Kenya, 2009)
- UNECA developing database/gazetteer software for African use ("GeoNyms")



Gaborone Action Plan 2011

- Improving national institutional arrangements with respect to geographical names authorities
 - Address benefits by increasing awareness; encouraging governments; establish network of contacts
- Increasing capacity building and knowledge sharing
 - Courses, workshops, on-line training
 - Promote cooperation, exchange, best national practices, workshops with conferences
- Promote coordination and cooperation at national, regional and global levels
- Address advances in communication and technology
